- A minimum of one semester of applied music is required before the recital. Not more than one-half of the total hours counted toward the planned program may be in applied music and recitals.
- Concurrent enrollment in (APPLIED INSTRUMENT) 5300 is required for each semester of enrollment in (APPLIED INSTRUMENT) 5501 and CONSVTY 5597.
- A graded half recital during the second semester of study on instruments #2 and #3 is required.
- Enroll in pedagogy on four different instruments.
- Two semesters or participation in a major ensemble are required on instrument #1. One semester of ensemble participation each is required on instruments #2 and #3.

Note: Jury approval of the 101(2) applied level or higher on instruments #4 and #5 is required before graduation.
