

LL.M. ACADEMIC RULES AND REGULATIONS

Appeal of Grades

The rules and regulations for the LL.M. programs in regard to appeal of grades is the same as specified for the Juris Doctor degree program.

Scholastic Probation and Dismissal

A student will be placed on scholastic probation if they fail to earn at least a grade of Credit in one course for the LL.M. in Lawyering. For the LL.M. in Lawyering, a student who fails to obtain a grade of at least Credit in a second course will be dismissed from the program for academic deficiency.

Attendance, Examinations, and Withdrawal from Courses

The rules and regulations for the LL.M. program in regard to attendance, examinations; and withdrawal from courses are the same as specified for the Juris Doctor degree programs, unless modified by the student's LLM advisor with the consent of the graduate studies committee
